- Snow Day & Hybrid options development underway

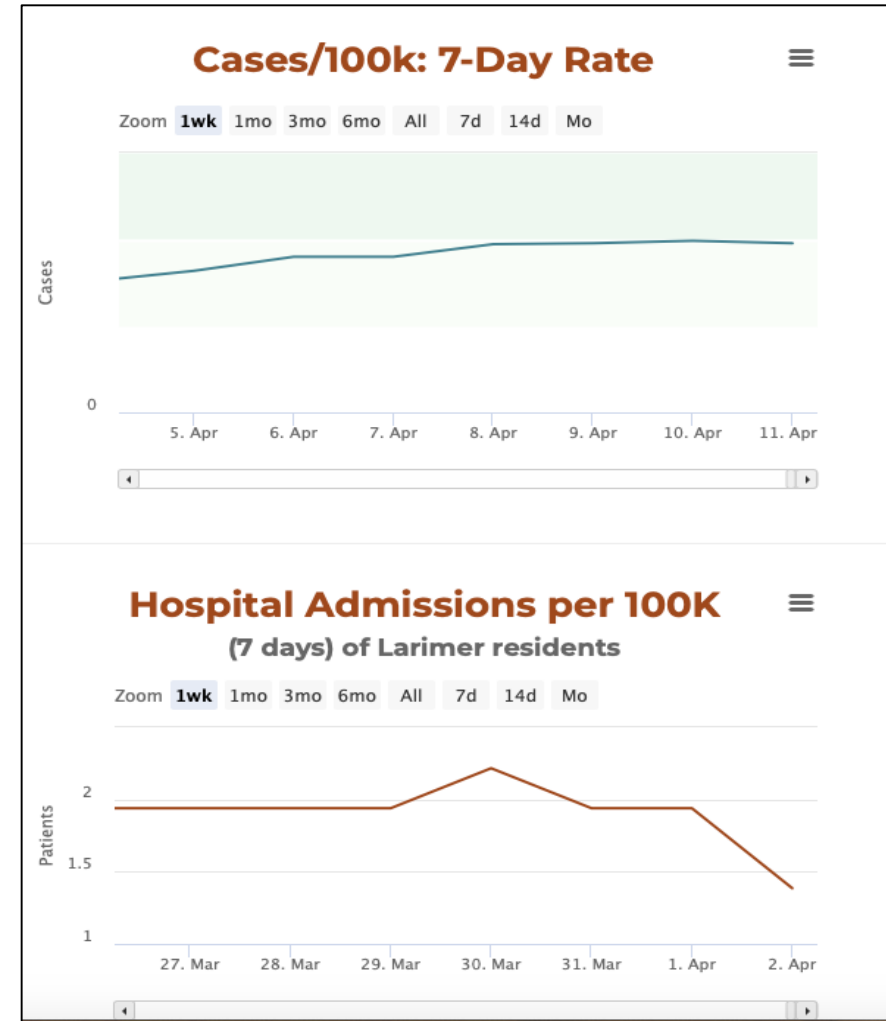

April BOD Update : COVID Snapshot

CDC & Larimer County Guidelines

- As of February 12, 2022
 - No local public health orders
 - No COVID-19 related restrictions
- Updates occur when guidelines change



April BOD Update : Plan

- Given the current CDC and Larimer County guidelines, continue planning for the Three Day program.
- Should guidance change before May 1, plan on the Hybrid model. May involve Board discussion.
- People can make a personal decision on housing and indoor activities.
- Communicate mask optional, until guidelines change.
- Cognizant of congregation of people during speaker times, dining indoors during inclement weather and indoor classes.
